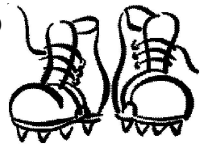
Managers/Coaches Meeting to be

TRAINING/TRAVELLING SHIRTS; JACKETS & SUPPORTER SHIRTS

A training/travelling shirt will be given to all junior players upon full payment of registration (Shirt will be available prior to first game). This shirt is to be worn to and from games and also at training. A \$10 refund will be given to players who wish to wear their existing shirt - this will be refunded from 1st game.

Under no circumstances are playing jerseys permitted to be worn at any time other than official fixtures.

Playing jerseys are not to be worn to and from games.

Club Jackets are available. Jackets are \$40 (all sizes).
